QUINN

NADIA

Oh, um yeah I actually just moved here. Names Nadia.

QUINN

NADIA

NADIA

3 EXT. WORK OUT PARK

QUINN

JAMES

5 INT. ANDRE'S HOUSE

JAMES

ANDRE

QUINN

She kissed me! And I mean, a full on kiss. The best kiss I've ever had.

JAMES

And then you fucked? Right there on the beach? My man!

QUINN

What? No, we just kissed.

ANDRE

It's a start.

JAMES

Yeah, if we were in middle school. Let me get this straight, you are sitting here, a grown ass man, bragging to your friends about kissing a girl?

QUINN

Well she kissed me.

JAMES

ANDRE

NADIA

Do it.

QUINN

Yeah.

NADIA

Damn millennials, always so involved in your feelings.

QUINN

You mad?

NADIA

No, I'm just giving you a hard time. So, Mr. Daly, what about the mysterious Nadia Juarez would you like to know?

QUINN

What makes you so mysterious?

NADIA

Oh a great many things, most of which you won't learn about, until you feel you know me well enough.

QUINN

You know, I feel like I know you a lot better now.

NADIA

I'm sure you do, but no, you started this. Let's see it through. So, growing up, it was just you and your mom?

QUINN

Yeah, uh, my father, he left my mom before he even knew she was pregnant. For another woman. I never really dealt with him too much. My mom would always push me to try, but he never really seemed to have any interest.

NADIA

I'm sorry to hear that.

QUINN

No, it's fine. It's life you know? So how about you? What was it like growing up?

NADIA

Annoying. Isn't that how it is with everyone?

QUINN

No, I mean, your home life.

NADIA

So do I. My parents got divorced when I was 10. It was a bitter divorce and my mom blamed me for it.

I'm sure that's not true.

NADIA

No, she told me, many many times that she blamed me. My dad, on the other hand, maintained that my mom was a pyscho and he couldn't stay in the same house with her anymore.

QUINN

Did you see much of him growing up?

NADIA

QUINN

NADIA

QUINN

I got X-Men #1, the '91 version not the one from the 60's, signed by both Jim Lee and Chris Clearmont. It was, to put it midly, the greatest day of my life. QUINN

That's a cheat.

NADIA

Just a bit. I guess if I had to pick one, it would be when my dad took me to the fair. I must have been 10 or so, it was right around the time my parents split. So it was a real big deal for me. My dad even won me a stuffed teddy bear. I named him Mr. Bear.

QUINN

So creative.

NADIA

painful for her)

It meant so much to me while I was at my moms house. It kept me sane.

What happened to it?

NADIA

My mom gave it to my baby cousin, about a year or so after I got it. She said I was too old for it. But that was bullshit. She just didn't like that I held onto a gift from my dad so hard. We didn't have the best relationship.

QUINN

I can see that. I'm sorry.

NADIA

Don't be.

(suddenly cheerful)

So, your first?

QUINN

Oh God. Um, well I was a bit older than I should have been.

NADIA

How old?

QUINN

23.

NADIA

Wow.

QUINN

Yeah. Her name was Christina. She was, not at all my type. We went to college together and got stuck in a group together. We started talking, and I don't know. It was like the whole world melted away, except for the two of us. After that we spent every moment together, until, well, until her ex got out of prison and she lost any interest in me.

NADIA

Not at all where I thought that story was going.

QUINN

It's called a plot twist.

NADIA

I see that. It was a good one.

Nah, it was a sucky one. I, I've never felt that way about anyone, before or since, well, until I laid eyes on you. The second I saw you, you took my breath away.

NADIA

Nice save.

QUINN

Wasn't it? I thought so.

NADIA

Same question?

QUINN

No. I mean, if you want to talk about your past relationships we can, but I will never ask you. Whatever relationships you had before me, that was before me and it is none of my business. I'm just honestly grateful that you had them. Because whatever you went through, good or bad, it helped turn you into the woman I see before me. And there is nothing about you that I would change.

NADIA

That was, that was something.

QUINN

Is there anything else you want to know? Cause I think I know all I need to.

NADIA

In that case I think I just have one more question.

QUINN

Whatever you want to know.

NADIA

Do you got a bedroom in here?

Quinn smiles.

JAMES (O.S.)

Bout fucking time!

James is once more working out.

QUINN

It was amazing man.

JAMES

I bet! I knew you had it in you.

QUINN

You do know I've had sex before right?

JAMES

Sometimes I'm not so sure. I mean, you say you have, but yeah, it could be a smokescreen.

QUINN

You're an asshole.

JAMES

I've been called worse.

QUINN

Somehow I believe that.

JAMES

I'm happy for you man.

QUINN

Thanks! I'm happy for myself. I don't think I've ever felt this happy before.

JAMES

Quinn, my man, don't think just cause you fucked her that this it's all roses from here on out. You gotta keep your feet on good old planet Earth. You hear me?

QUINN

I know. She wants me to meet her dad this weekend.

JAMES

Whoa, abort my man, abort.

QUINN

Why?

JAMES

She wants you to meet her dad? That's a level of commitment you are not ready for. Trust me. I say, you turn around and run. And keep running till you hit like China or some shit, and then keep running. Or better yet, break into NASA, still a shuttle and fly right into the sun, cause you have a better chance of coming out the other side of that, than you do making it through dinner with her pops.

QUINN

(laughs)

I'm sure.

JAMES

You think I'm playing, but trust me, there is nothing more dangerous than dinner with the girl you just started dating's father. I should know.

QUINN

You've been through it a lot?

JAMES

Never once, that's why I'm still alive. I'm not stupid.

QUINN

Sometimes I wonder.

JAMES

Alright, don't believe me. But, when he is strangling you to death, don't say I didn't warn you.

QUINN

Fair enough.

11 INT. OFFICE

11

Quinn is sitting at a desk, a look of utter defeat on his face.

QUINN

He's going to hate me.

James sits down next to him.

JAMES

If it makes you feel any better, he was going to hate you no matter what, you are fucking his daughter after all.

QUINN

There was a chance he'd like me.

JAMES

Not a one.

Andre looks up from the paper work spread out in front of him.

ANDRE

What are you two going on about?

JAMES

Quinn's fantasies.

QUINN

I was supposed to have dinner with Nadia and her father tonight. It was going to be the big night, where I meet him. She said she never introduced a guy to her dad before so this was a really big deal for her. And I ruined it.

JAMES

Which, we all knew you would.

ANDRE

Shut up Jim. You didn't ruin it, our client ruined it. And I'm sure they all understand that sometimes shit comes up.

QUINN

What if they don't understand?

ANDRE

Than she isn't the girl for you. We're in advertising, shit like this happens all the time. If Gina freaked out every time I was forced to work late, our relationship wouldn't work. There has to be a level of understanding.

QUINN

Advertising, ugh, this wasn't supposed to be my life.

(MORE)

QUINN (CONT'D)

I was going to be a superstar artist, drawing Uncanny X-Men. Not stuck drawing ads for tiny stores that no one even cares about.

ANDRE

Oh, so these people and their tiny stores don't matter. They aren't as important as Xavier and his band of Mutants, I'm so sorry to hear that. Do you know how many people would kill for your job, and you just sitting here bitching and moaning about it.

QUINN

I had a date!

ANDRE

No one fucking cares. You're a God damn man, who was paid to do a fucking job, so fucking do it. You feel bad for bailing on Nadia and her dad, that's fine. Make it up to them. No one is telling you not to. But don't waste my time with your pity party. I would like to get home tonight. I have better things to do than sit here and listen to a grown ass man whine.

JAMES

You tell him Dre!

ANDRE

Shut the fuck up Jim, you're no better. Sitting there egging him on.

JAMES

Hey now, I'm just warning him. Do you remember the first time you met Gina's dad?

ANDRE

Yeah, it was awkward, but other than that it went fine.

(turns to Quinn)

Don't let this fool, who has never even had a second date, put doubts in your head about your relationship.

(MORE)

ANDRE (CONT'D)

Just text, tell her you can't make it due to work and you'll make it up to her. It's not a big deal.

QUINN

I already did, she hasn't responded.

ANDRE

She will.

OUINN

And if she doesn't?

ANDRE

Than she doesn't and you move on.

QUINN

That's it? I just move on.

ANDRE

Yeah. If she gets this upset because of something outside of your control, than you're better off knowing that now. That's not someone you need in your life.

QUINN

That's cynical man.

ANDRE

No, that's factual. Now, for the love of God, can we please, get to work? Because while this might not be your dream job Quinn, it is mine. And I don't want to lose it.

OUINN

Yeah, sorry man.

ANDRE

It's fine.

12 EXT. OUTSIDE OFFICE

12

Quinn exits the building, looking kind of down, checking his phone.

James runs up behind him.

JAMES

She respond?

OUINN

Two words. It fine. Not it's, just it.

JAMES

I'm not sure that makes a difference. You know how many words I mess up in texting. It's texting, half the time I'm not even looking at my phone while I text.

QUINN

I've text with you before, I'm well aware. But she's not you. She's mad. I don't blame her.

JAMES

She has nothing to be mad about.

QUINN

This was a big deal to her and I cancelled at the last second.

JAMES

Okay, that is something to be mad at, but like Dre said, it was outside of your control. That's the nature of the career we chose.

QUINN

You chose. You and Andre. I took this job to work with you guys and get paid for drawing while I submitted to Marvel. Which I still have no real clue how to do. I try contests and conventions. Maybe I'm just, I don't know, not good enough.

JAMES

You really down in the dumps today aren't you?

QUINN

Shouldn't I be? I'm damn near 30 and I have nothing in my life to show for it.

JAMES

Nothing? You have a great girl who loves you.

QUINN

Do I? It fine, she hates me.

JAMES

She's upset, and you only get that upset when someone you love does something, that alone proves how much she loves you.

QUINN

If you say so.

JAMES

I do. I'd also point out, that while it may not be your dream job, you do have a damn good one. I know in your eyes it's a dead end job, but it's really not that bad if you just stop thinking about where you want to be and take a look around at where you are.

QUINN

A parking lot?

JAMES

Funny. No I mean in life. Oh, and one last thing you have, Mr. I have nothing, the best motherfucking friends on the planet. You know how lucky you are to know me? You best be thankful son.

QUINN

(laughs)

Shut the fuck up.

JAMES

There we go. Don't worry about Nadia, she's just upset, she'll get over it.

He heads towards his car.

QUINN

I hope your right!

Quinn starts towards his.

JAMES

I always am!

He calls back as he gets into his car.

Quinn stops in front of his and looks back at his phone.

QUINN (TEXT)

Do you hate me?

He gets into the car.

13 INT. ANDRE'S HOUSE

13

Quinn takes a sip of his beer. Sitting with Andre and James.

QUINN

It's been 3 days and I still haven't heard from her.

JAMES

I can't believe you asked her that!

QUINN

Why not? I really felt like she hated me, I just wanted to know.

ANDRE

Please tell me you didn't text her again after that?

QUINN

No, of course not.

ANDRE

Good.

QUINN

Maybe 3 or 4 times.

ANDRE

Fuck.

JAMES

Quinn!

QUINN

And another 5 yesterday. And I may have called her a few times, no answer.

JAMES

Well put a fork in it, this relationship is done.

QUINN

That's why I'm trying to talk to her! To fix it!

ANDRE

You aren't fixing it, you're making it worse.

JAMES

Yeah, girls don't like that clingy shit.

ANDRE

I don't think anyone does.

JAMES

Point!

QUINN

So what do I do?

JAMES

You Catholic right?

QUINN

Yeah, what does that have to do with anything?

JAMES

Priesthood my friend. Cause let's be honest, it was a miracle you got her, you're not getting another one.

QUINN

(laughs)

Fuck off man. I'm being serious.

JAMES

So am I.

ANDRE

You need to give her time and hope she comes back to you. But if she doesn't, than you have to let her go. You don't really have another option.

JAMES

I mean, he could always go the romcom route.

ANDRE

No, no he can't. Those are movies, cheesy movies at that. Not real life. Besides, he's already done too much.

(MORE)

ANDRE (CONT'D)

Right now, the best thing he can do is pull back. Let her cool off.

QUINN

You're saying I need a big romantic gesture?

JAMES

Yes!

ANDRE

This is going to go horribly wrong.

JAMES

Unless it goes horribly right!

ANDRE

What does that even mean?

QUINN

So, what should I do?

James starts pacing back and forth, putting on his best thinking face. He stops and snaps his fingers.

JAMES

I got it! You rent a blimp, one of those ones that say messages. And you have it read, Nadia, can you ever forgive me? It'll work like a charm.

ANDRE

No. So help me, if you do that, if you even think about doing that, I will smack you upside the head. That is the single stupidest thing I've ever heard in my entire life. And I've known him damn near most of it. That will not work. Never in the history of real life, or even fictional worlds, has that ever worked!

JAMES

Has so!

ANDRE

Name some time it's worked!

JAMES

It'll come to me!

OUINN

So what would you suggest?

ANDRE

Waiting, but if you're sure about this big gesture thing.

QUINN

I am.

ANDRE

Than it has to be something special.

JAMES

Blimps are special!

ANDRE

It has to be something that you can only do for her. Something that if you did it for any other woman it would be meaningless, but for Nadia, it would be the most meaningful, romantic gesture imaginable.

OUINN

And what would that be?

ANDRE

How would I know? You were the one dating her, this is something that you should know. It has to be something that she wants, that maybe she doesn't even know she wants, but when you show her, she realizes that it was the only thing she ever wanted. You want to be her boyfriend, show her that you know her, that you love her.

JAMES

With a blimp.

ANDRE

Get the fuck out of my house!

Andre starts pushing him towards the door.

JAMES

What? I'm just saying.

ANDRE

Out! Out! Get the fuck out!

James ducks under Andre's arm and makes his way back towards Quinn.

JAMES

Nah, but, all jokes aside, Dre is right.

ANDRE

Thank you.

QUINN

(nods)

I know.

JAMES

So what are you going to do?

14 EXT. OUTSIDE NADIA'S APARTMENT

14

Nadia walks up to her apartment, it looks empty. She gets closer and closer when Quinn pops out. His hands behind his back.

NADIA

Ahh! What the hell!

QUINN

Sorry, I just, I uh.

NADIA

You what? Wanted to scare me to death?

QUINN

No! Just to give you this.

NADIA

Wha. . .

She stops mid word when she sees what he is holding out for her. It is Mr. Bear, a bit beat up and his stomach was clearly sown together poorly.

NADIA (CONT'D)

Mr. Bear?

QUINN

Yeah, I uh, I tracked your cousin down on Facebook. I asked if he still had him and he let me check in his shed. Sure enough I found him. Took me a while, but he was there.

He hands him over to her.

QUINN (CONT'D)

He was in pretty bad shape, I had to replace a lot of the stuffing and find something to replace his midsection, I'm not a seamstress by any stretch of the imagination, but I did the best I could.

NADIA

Seamster, and it's perfect.

QUINN

What?

NADIA

Seamstress is a woman, seamster is a man. I, I just can't believe you did this for me.

QUINN

(nods, unsure if he should speak)

I uh, I just wanted to tell you how sorry I am, for missing your dinner with your father. I know how important that was to you.

She looks up at him, all happiness gone, replaced with sorrow and anger. She throws Mr. Bear back at him.

NADIA

I. . .I just can't do this right
now!

She pushes past him to her door, which she hurries to unlock. He looks down at the stuffed animal in his hands. He looks back up as she gets the door open. She stops and looks back at him.

QUINN

Nadia?

She thinks for a second and then snatches Mr. Bear from his hands and slams the door in his face.

GINA (O.S.)

So she took the bear?

Quinn nods. He is sitting across from Gina, as Andre makes himself something to eat.

GINA

Well that's a good sign. It means that you picked the right gesture.

OUINN

She slammed the door in my face!

GINA

But not before taking the teddy. That's a good sign.

QUINN

But she wouldn't even talk to me.

ANDRE

I never said it would be a quick fix. You made a heart felt move, that seems to have hit a nerve with her. Let her dwell on it a bit, she'll come back to you.

GINA

I'm sure of it. That was so romantic.

She hits Andre.

GINA (CONT'D)

Why don't you ever do anything romantic like that?

ANDRE

Because I don't fuck up like him!

GINA

Oh, so you can only do romantic stuff when you fuck up? Everything I do for you, and I only deserve sweet things when you mess up. I'll remember that.

ANDRE

Not, not at all what I'm saying.

GINA

That's what I heard. Isn't that what you heard Quinn?

Andre shakes his head no behind Gina's back, pleading with Quinn.

QUINN

More or less.

ANDRE

(hisses)

Asshole!

16 EXT. WORK OUT PARK

16

James is working out as Quinn sits nearby.

JAMES

Fuck that. Now is not the time to sit by and wait. She liked the first gesture but still slammed the door in your face, that means it wasn't enough.

OUINN

That's what it means?

JAMES

Yes sir, you gotta double down!

QUINN

Isn't that what got me into trouble in the first place? Doubling down on the text messages?

JAMES

Yeah, because that was clingy. This is romantic. There's a difference.

OUINN

Are you sure?

JAMES

Have I ever steered you wrong?

QUINN

Many, many times. Far more times than I can count. In fact, I don't know if you've ever done anything but steer me wrong.

JAMES

That's cold. You come here and interrupt my work out, just to insult me.

QUINN

How am I interrupting your work out? You're still working out.

JAMES

Yeah, but I'm having to listen to you while I do it, that's not fun,

QUINN

Well sorry.

JAMES

You should be! Look, at the end of the day, this is your life, your relationship, so you do what you want. But, I think she torn on if she should forgive you or not. That stuffed animal from her dad, that was smooth. It really was, and it will no doubt go a long way towards winning her back. But if you can grease the wheel a little bit. Do something that just pushes it over the edge, you'll win her back for sure.

QUINN

JAMES

QUINN

JAMES

(smiles)

That's the part that wins her back. You sacrifice something that means everything to you, to show her a good time.

17 EXT. OUTSIDE NADIA'S APARTMENT

17

Quinn walks up to the door, he is about to knock when the door swings open with a hurried looking Nadia standing there.

Quinn what the fuck!

QUINN

Sorry, I was about to knock.

NADIA

What do you want? I was on my way out.

She says as she locks her door.

QUINN

I was hoping you'd let me take you away this weekend. I rented a cabin out by the lake.

NADIA

You did what?

QUINN

I thought it could be a romantic getaway. It's really nice, you would love it.

NADIA

You rented a cabin for the weekend?

QUINN

Yeah.

NADIA

Without checking with me first?

QUINN

I wanted to surprise you.

NADIA

Well it worked. How could you even afford that?

QUINN

I uh, I sold my copy of X-Men #1.

NADIA

The one your grandfather got you?

QUINN

Yeah.

NADIA

Your dead grandfather?

OUINN

Yeah, I wanted to show you that you mean more to me, than anything else. I thought this would be a nice gesture.

NADIA

A nice gesture? You didn't even ask me I wanted to go before you sold a priceless memory. What the fuck is wrong with you? Do you have any idea how fucked up that is? Not to mention, the complete disrespect towards me. You just assume I have nothing going on in my life, that I can just drop everything and run off to the woods with you. Are you serious?

QUINN

I. . . I didn't, I didn't think.

NADIA

No, no you didn't. You never do, that's the problem. You're so wrapped up in what you got going on that you never stop and think about what anyone else has going on. You're an asshole.

She storms past him.

QUINN

Nadia!

She doesn't look back.

CLERK (O.S.)

I'm sorry sir.

18 INT. COMIC BOOK STORE

18

Quinn is standing in front of a clerk.

CLERK

I already sold the book. That was a hot item, went out literally minutes after you brought it in.

QUINN

I understand.

Off of the devastated look on his face we

DISSOLVE TO:

19 EXT. LAKE

19

Where we pull back from his face to see him skip a rock across the lake, or at least try to.

QUINN

What the fuck is wrong with me? Everything I do in life just turns to shit!

He goes and sits down near the water.

QUINN (CONT'D)

I mean, is it so much to ask for one win, just one. One tiny little victory in the shit show that is my life. It doesn't even have to be a big win. Just something. Something to give me hope for tomorrow. Not one crushing defeat after the next. It's just. . .it's just too much.

He is on the verge of tears.

20 INT. ANDRE'S HOUSE

20

James takes a sip of his beer as Andre opens his.

ANDRE

Where could he be? It's not like Quinn to miss guys night.

JAMES

I don't know man, I tried calling him and texting him, but no answer.

ANDRE

He's taking all this really hard.

JAMES

I mean, it's his first serious relationship in forever, can you blame him.

ANDRE

I just hope he's okay.

JAMES

I'm sure he is! I mean, for all we know, the grand gesture worked and he's with Nadia right now.

ANDRE

I don't know. The last time I talked to him she slammed the door in his face. I mean, I guess she could have called him, but I wouldn't count on it.

JAMES

Yeah, but I meant his second grand gesture.

ANDRE

His what now?

JAMES

The second grand gesture he made.

ANDRE

What second grand gesture? I talked him out of doing anything else. He said he was just going to wait and hear from her.

JAMES

Yeah, until he talked to me. I convinced him he needed to step up his game. Show her how much he cares.

ANDRE

Which he did, with the stuffed animal. What did you do Jim?

JAMES

I convinced him to take her out to a cabin by the lake.

ANDRE

That's pricey.

JAMES

Tell me about it. He had to see his X-Men #1 to do.

ANDRE

The signed one? The one he got from his grandfather?

JAMES

That's the one.

ANDRE

Why would you let him do that?

JAMES

So he could show her how much he cares. That is the biggest gesture you can make my friend. That's his checkmate.

ANDRE

JAMES

(shrugs, uncomfortable
 with where this is going)
Be sad?

ANDRE

JAMES

ANDRE

Yeah you do, I wish you wouldn't, but you do. No, we need to go by his house and check on him. Make sure he's okay.

Andre starts towards the door. James finishes his beer and gets up.

JAMES

That's not where he'd be.

21 EXT. LAKE 21

Quinn throws another rock into the lake, looking even more defeated than when we left him.

JAMES (O.C.)

Told you this is where he would be.

Quinn turns around to find James and Andre walking over towards him.

QUINN

What do you guys want?

ANDRE

To make sure you're okay.

QUINN

Well I'm not, so you did what you set out to do. See ya.

They sit down next to him.

ANDRE

What happened?

Quinn gets up.

QUINN

I don't want to talk about it.

Andre gets up and goes after him, James stays where he is, the guilt pouring off of him.

ANDRE

What happened?

Quinn turns to face Andre.

QUINN

The same thing that always happens. I fucked up. Yet again. Same old Quinn, finding new ways to mess my life up, day after day.

ANDRE

What did she say.

QUINN

A lot, a whole lot. She was mad I rented a cabin without telling her, she was pissed I sold my comic. Not that it's any of her business, but whatever. She said I didn't respect her, that I just assumed she had no life. What does that even mean? I was trying to be sweet. Trying to show her that she means more to me than some stupid magazine. Some stupid magazine that is all that I had left of my Grandfather.

(MORE)

QUINN (CONT'D)

ANDRE

ANDRE

Don't say that.

QUINN

Why? It's true.

ANDRE

No it's not! Look Quinn, I know this shit seems bad, and it is. But what you need to understand is, this is what life is. It's a series of ups and downs. This, this right here, is just a moment in time and it will pass. I promise you.

Quinn nods.

QUINN

I know, it's just, I just, I want a win. Just once.

In the background James looks over and nods.

James, holding a brown bag, knocks on the door. Quinn answers.

QUINN

James? What are you doing here.

JAMES

I uh, I thought a lot about what you were saying yesterday, at the lake, and uh, I wanted to give you this.

He hands him the brown bag.

Quinn takes it and pulls out a copy of X-Men #1, signed by Jim Lee and Chris Clearmont.

QUINN

Is this? Oh my God is this. . .

JAMES

(nods)

It's your copy. After you left the park I followed you to the comic store, or well to your apartment and then to the comic store. I went in right after you left and bought it.

QUINN

Why?

JAMES

Because, I honestly thought that you sacrificing what you love the most would move her. That it would win her back. I thought that act would fix everything, that's why I suggested it. But I wasn't about to let you give up something that means that much to you, something that is that irreplaceable. I figured I'd buy it back and give it to you for your birthday next month.

QUINN

Dude.

JAMES

I know I joke that I want you guys to be single and that relationships are the devil, but I really do want you to be happy. And she seems to do that for you. Maybe. . . maybe the weekend getaway was a bit much. Maybe there is something you could do that is a bit closer to home? I don't know. Just a thought.

Quinn nods as he looks back down at his comic.

JAMES (CONT'D)

But either way, that there, that's your win. Maybe you can make it a streak.

23 EXT. OUTSIDE NADIA'S APARTMENT

2.3

Nadia walks slowly towards her apartment, clearly keeping an eye out for Quinn.

He's no where to be seen.

She unlocks the door. And pushes it open.

24 INT. NADIA'S APARTMENT

24

Inside is Quinn, smiling, standing in front of a dressed table with food laid out.

NADIA

Quinn?

QUINN

Hey Nadia.

NADIA

What. . . what is this? What are you doing here?

OUINN

I made you dinner.

He takes a step towards her, she takes a step back. The tone starts to shift a bit.

NADIA

I can see that.

QUINN

I gotta be honest, I'm not the best cook, but I tried.

She nods, not really listening. She is scared.

QUINN (CONT'D)

I uh, I thought a lot about what you said, the last time I saw you. About the, uh about the weekend getaway. You uh, you were right. I was being selfish and disrespectful.

NADIA

(nervous)

Uh huh.

QUINN

I didn't stop to think about what you might have going on. That might be hard for you to just get away for a weekend. So I thought, maybe this would be better. It's at home, on your schedule. It's perfect.

NADIA

How. . .how did you get in?

QUINN

Oh, uh, the, your, your key. On the side of the door.

He points to it sitting on the table. She looks from the key to him.

QUINN (CONT'D)

Did I do good?

NADIA

Did you do good?

QUINN

Yeah?

NADIA

You think this is okay?

QUINN

Isn't it? You didn't want to go away, so I bought the apology to you.

By breaking into my home.

QUINN

Wait, what?

NADIA

What the fuck is wrong with you?

QUINN

I thought you would like it.

NADIA

You thought I would like you breaking into my house and invading, this is literally an invasion, do you know that?

QUINN

No, no this is, this is me making a grand gesture.

NADIA

No, no this not a grand gesture. This is, this is terrifying. Coming home to find someone just broke in and waited for you. You have any idea how scary that is?

QUINN

Scary? Nadia it's me. You know me. I would never do anything to hurt me.

NADIA

Do I? Do I know that? Because before 10 minutes ago, I knew beyond a shadow of a doubt you would never break into my home. I was wrong about that, what else am I wrong about?

QUINN

I was trying to be sweet!

NADIA

Well you missed the mark, I can tell you that much!

QUINN

I'm lost here Nadia, tell me what I have to do. I'm just, I'm just trying to put things right.

You have to get out.

OUINN

You want me to leave?

NADIA

Yes! Right now! Right the fuck now!

He nods and slowly walks out. The second he is outside he turns to face her, tears in his eyes.

QUINN

I'm so sorry.

Mid sentence she slams the door shut in his face, presses herself against the door and locks both locks. Her breath rapid, she is scared for her life.

QUINN (O.C.) (CONT'D)

I'm so sorry Nadia! I really am!

She lowers herself to the floor, her eyes wide in panic.

QUINN (O.C.) (CONT'D)

I'd do anything for you. Anything.

Just name it!

NADTA

Leave!

QUINN (O.C.)

Nadia please!

NADIA

Just leave me alone!

She holds her head in her hands. After a few moments when no reply comes she slowly crawls over to the table and gets to her feet. She looks around at the dinner he made. It looks lovely.

QUINN (O.C.)

I love you!

She is startled by his voice and flinches. She reaches into her purse and pulls out her phone, putting the purse down on the table. She starts calling someone.

QUINN (O.C.) (CONT'D)

Please just say something. I know you love me too!

She goes into the closet.

Sam? Hey, um can I come spend the night.

(listens)

I just really don't want to be alone right now.

(listens)

Thanks.

She hangs up the phone and gets up, slowly exiting the closet. She stops and listens.

SILENCE

She moves towards the table and picks up her purse.

QUINN (O.C.)

If you really want me to leave I will. I just. . .I just want you to be happy.

She stops dead in her tracks. She shallows hard and waits for him to say something else.

After a few moments of silence she pulls out a thing of mace. She starts towards the door, slowly.

She looks out the peephole. There doesn't appear to be anyone there.

She looks out the blinds, still no one there.

She waits a second and unlocks the top lock.

She waits, nothing.

She unlocks the other lock.

She waits, nothing.

She takes a deep breath and holds the mace up.

She slowly opens the door, peeking outside, while still pressed against the door, in case she needs to force it shut.

There is no one there.

25 EXT. OUTSIDE NADIA'S APARTMENT

2.5

She slowly makes her way outside, keeping the hand with the mace in it up.

She hurries and locks the door.

She slowly makes her way away from her apartment, her hand at the ready to fire, her eyes scanning around for any sign of him.

He is nowhere to be seen.

She runs to her car.

She fumbles for the keys and unlocks the car, getting inside.

26 I/E. CAR 26

Once inside she hurries and locks the door, her breaking rapid.

27 EXT. PARKING LOT.

27

She pulls out of the parking space and speeds off.

SAM (O.S.)

I can't believe he did that!

28 INT. SAM'S APARTMENT

28

A still shaken Nadia sits next to her best friend SAM on her couch.

NADIA

You have no idea how terrifying it is to just come home and have someone in your home like that.

SAM

I can't even imagine.

NADIA

It's just such an invasion.

SAM

That's so creepy. I never would have thought, it's just, you always made him out to seem like such a great guy.

NADIA

(shakes her head)

The first time we met he shocked me. I should have known then. I me if that isn't a sign he is dangerous, than what is.

SAM

I'm so sorry Nadia.

NADIA

Sam, it's just. . . I'm scared to go to my own home. You know how fucked up that is?

SAM

That's pretty fucked up.

NADIA

It is. I can't believe him. I trusted him. And he's ruined everything.

SAM

I'm so sorry.

NADIA

It's never going to be okay.

SAM

Do you want to call the cops?

NADIA

What can they do? They can't undo what he did.

SAM

They can arrest him. Make you feel safe in your home again.

She shakes her head.

NADIA

He was just so sweet, so kind. I've never met anyone like him.

SAM

What changed?

Nadia looks away.

SAM (CONT'D)

Nadia, what aren't you telling me?

Nadia looks back at her.

NADIA

My dad.

SAM

Oh God Nadia, I'm so sorry.

(shakes her head, tears
 flowing from her eyes)
You don't know. You just don't
know. No one knows.

SAM

Knows what? Nadia, what happened?

Nadia wipes away her tears.

NADTA

It's all Quinn's fault. It's all my fault. It's all our fault.

SAM

The accident? How?

NADIA

Everything. . . everything was going perfect. I've never been so happy in my entire life. I told Quinn, I told him I wanted him to meet my father.

SAM

That's a big step.

NADIA

The biggest. I've never let anyone I've dated near him before. This was a, a game changer.

SAM

I bet your dad was excited, finally meet someone his little girl thinks is worthy.

NADIA

He was, and then Quinn ruined it. Ruined my life.

SAM

How?

Nadia gets up and starts walking away. Sam follows her.

SAM (CONT'D)

Nadia, what did he do?

Nadia doesn't answer. Sam walks in front of her.

SAM (CONT'D)

You can tell me. Whatever it is. I'm here for you.

Nadia nods.

NADIA

I was getting ready. I was so. . .I was so nervous, but also excited, and scared and a whole wash of emotions. All at the same time, you know?

SAM

I know the feeling.

NADIA

It was about an hour before he was supposed to pick me up and he texts me. Didn't even bother to call, mind you, he just text me, and said he was hung up at work and wouldn't be able to make it.

SAM

Hung up at work? What does he do?

NADIA

He works as a storyboard artist for some ad company, I don't know. I guess some big client they had rejected their proposal so they had to stay late and come up with a new one.

SAM

That sucks.

Nadia nods.

NADIA

I just text him back and said it's fine.

SAM

Think he knew it wasn't?

NADIA

Oh he knew. He started texting me about how sorry he was, and how he hates his job and will make it up to me. He wouldn't leave me the fuck alone.

SAM

What did you say back?

NADIA

Nothing, I just ignored him. I was pissed.

SAM

You had every right to be.

NADIA

And the more he texted me, the more pissed I became.

SAM

I would have too.

NADIA

I told my dad he had to work late and couldn't make it. And you know my dad, he took it fine. Just that's cool. Some other time. As if it was no big deal.

SAM

But it was a big deal.

NADIA

The biggest. And then, then my dad asked me. . .

(she starts to cry)

He asked me if I still wanted to come over and have dinner with him.

SAM

You said no?

Nadia falls back onto the couch.

NADIA

I said no. I was so pissed off at Quinn, that I just didn't want to do anything! I just wanted to stay at home and be pissed.

SAM

There's nothing wrong with wanting alone time, I'm sure your dad understood.

NADIA

Of course he did. He said raincheck and that he loved me. I didn't think anything else about him.

(MORE)

NADIA (CONT'D)

I just planned fights with Quinn in my head. Until I got the call.

SAM

Oh God.

NADIA

It seems my dad went out to get something to eat since we weren't coming over, and that. . .that's when.

SAM

When the other car ran the red light and hit him.

Nadia nods.

NADIA

It's my fault. All because of Quinn and his stupid job. My dad hasn't woken up, in almost a week, and all Quinn cares about is me not being mad at him. As if that's important.

SAM

I'm so sorry Nadia.

NADIA

And then, he just. . . he keeps showing up at my house, making things worse. Did I tell you he went to Andrew's house?

SAM

Your cousin?

NADIA

Yes girl! He tracked him down and got Mr. Bear from his shed. He even fixed him up, did the worst sowing job I've ever seen.

SAM

The bear that your dad gave you when we were kids?

NADIA

(nods)

The one and the same. Just throwing in my face that I could lose my dad at any moment.

SAM

He couldn't have known.

NADIA

I know, I know. I just, I needed some time.

SAM

I know.

NADIA

But he didn't give it to me. Instead he shows up, talking about taking me to some cabin for the weekend. As if I could get away right now, with everything going on.

SAM

I hate to say it, but maybe that's what you need. A few days away.

NADIA

Maybe. And it was tempting, but. .
.he paid for it by selling the last gift his grandfather got him before dying. His grandfather was the closet thing he had to a father and he sold his memory of him for what? A weekend getaway? What kind of monster does that?

SAM

Are you serious?

NADIA

Yes girl! If. . .if dad. . .if he doesn't. . .if he doesn't wake up, I would never, I would never get rid of anything he got me. How do you just throw those memories aside. For what? I just. . .I couldn't.

Sam hugs Nadia tight.

SAM

It's okay Nadia. It's okay.

DISSOLVE TO:

Nadia is sleeping on the couch. We can hear someone moving around. She jumps up, still shaken from the night before.

Sam is in the kitchen cooking.

NADIA

Sam?

SAM

Oh, sorry Nadia. I was trying not to disturb you.

NADIA

It's fine. Sorry, just kind of jumpy.

Sam nods as she puts some food on a plate.

SAM

Understandable.

She walks the plate over to Nadia.

SAM (CONT'D)

How do you feel?

Nadia takes the plate and starts playing around with the food.

NADIA

How am I supposed to feel?

SAM

However you're feeling. There is no right or wrong way to feel. You just, you feel how you feel.

Nadia nods, Sam smiles at her and then heads back into the kitchen.

Nadia puts the plate on the table.

NADIA

Thank you for everything Sam.

Sam starts making herself a plate.

SAM

Don't mention it. It's what friends are for.

You really are a good friend.

SAM

I'm the best, what are you talking about!

NADIA

That you are.

Sam comes and sits down next to Nadia, with her plate. Unlike Nadia she eats some.

SAM

So what are you going to do?

NADIA

Honestly? I don't know. I still feel a little weirded out by going home.

SAM

You can stay here as long as you like.

NADIA

I appreciate that, but I'm going to have to go home eventually.

SAM

You can still report him.

NADIA

No, I'm just, well if he does something else, maybe, but I'm just going to let it go.

SAM

You sure?

NADIA

I'm sure. I don't think he's going to try anything like that again. At least I hope not.

SAM

I can't imagine he would, but than again, who would have thought he would have done that in the first place.

NADIA

Good point. I just, I just don't want to be afraid of my own home.

SAM

Nor should you have to. He had no right to make you feel that way.

Nadia nods.

NADIA

I know.

SAM

So what are going to do?

NADIA

I think I'll go visit my dad and then head home. See how I feel once I'm there.

SAM

If you need anything, and I mean anything. I'm here.

NADIA

I know. I love you girl.

SAM

I love you too!

They hug.

30 EXT. PARKING LOT.

30

Nadia parks her car in her normal spot. She gets out and spots Quinn getting out of his car not far off.

She freezes.

He locks eyes with her.

She reaches into her purse and starts to pull out the mace. The mace never makes it out of the bag.

He looks down and walks away.

She relaxes and drops the mace.

She takes a deep breath and heads towards her apartment.

31 EXT. OUTSIDE NADIA'S APARTMENT

31

She stops in front of her door and looks around. There is no one there. She opens the door and heads inside.

32 INT. NADIA'S APARTMENT

32

It's still set up like the date night.

The tension and fear return, it's all over her face.

She hurries and closes the door and locks the bottom lock.

She goes to lock the bottom, but thinks back to him walking away.

She lets out a breath of relief and turns away from the door. She starts putting away the stuff on the table.

GINA (0.S.)
And you just walked away?

33 INT. ANDRE'S HOUSE

33

Quinn nods. He is in the living room with Gina, Andre and James.

Andre hands him a beer.

JAMES

That much have been hard for you man.

ANDRE

Well what else was he going to do after he broke into her apartment. He's lucky she didn't throw his ass in jail.

GINA

Yeah, I personally would have stopped with getting her teddy bear back. I mean, that was so romantic.

ANDRE

Yeah, I don't know why that didn't win her over. Oh, because you kept trying to one up yourself. Right into a home invasion.

QUINN

I get it.

ANDRE

Do you? Because I just want to make sure.

QUINN

I do.

GINA

So what now?

ANDRE

What do you mean what now? That's it! He walked away, just like he should have from the jump. Don't back slide now.

QUINN

I won't.

JAMES

And maybe in a few weeks, you can, I don't know, send her a text saying sorry for everything.

ANDRE GINA

No!

No!

James puts his hands up.

JAMES (CONT'D)

It was just a suggestion.

ANDRE

He already did too much. Anything else would just be crossing a line.

GINA

If she wants to talk to him, she will. Otherwise, just, it's done.

QUINN

I know. It sucks but I know.

ANDRE

You'll get through this man, and next time, you'll learn from all this.

GINA

And there will be a next time. I promise you.

QUINN

I know. I just miss her.

GINA

I know.

OUINN

I can't help thinking about everything I could have done different. All the mistakes I made. Everything that I'm now missing out on because of it. It's all so much.

GINA

It'll get easier.

JAMES

It's your mind-set man.

QUINN

How do you mean?

JAMES

It's what I keep trying to tell you. You spend far too much time and energy worrying about what is coming up ahead and not enough time in the present. Years from now, hopefully many, many, many years from now, when you're old and on your death bed, you won't be laying there thinking about how your life was supposed to be. Or what you never got around to. You'll be thinking about the moments you did have, and the moments you let slip past you. You need to stop stressing so much about the future and start living in the now. You'll be much happier.

ANDRE

That was surprisingly deep.

QUINN

Seriously. Who are you and what have you done with James?

JAMES

Look, all I'm saying is that you gotta live in the moment. Because, I mean, well, what could have been with her, that shits gone. Doesn't matter anymore. It just doesn't. But what does matter, what is important. Is the time you spent with her. That's what you hold with you.

ANDRE

(sarcastic)

I think I might cry.

QUINN

For real. That uh. . . Thanks man. That means a lot. It was. . I don't know. Who knew you had something like that in you?

GINA

I knew he did. He's a bigger romantic than the two of you. He just hides it behind his stupidity.

JAMES

Hey now! You can't prove that! In fact, not only can you not prove that, but that is borderline slander and I can sue you for that shit. Hell, when I'm done with you, I'd own this whole house. You can't just be telling lies on people like that.

ANDRE

Damn Gina, you hit a nerve.

GINA

James is a big old softy.

JAMES

Man I'mma bout to leave.

QUINN

In all seriousness, I really think I needed to hear that man. Thanks.

JAMES

I have my moments.

QUINN

You guys, you don't know how much it means to me that you guys are always here for me. No matter how much I mess up. Or what, whatever. It means a lot.

GINA

Of course. It's what family is for.

ANDRE

You do the same for us. And like I said, you'll get through this.

QUINN

I know.

34 EXT. PARKING LOT.

34

Quinn pulls into the parking lot and gets out of the car. He spots Nadia's car and stops for a moment before letting out a sigh and heading home.

35 EXT. OUTSIDE QUINN'S APARTMENT

35

He walks up to his door and unlocks it.

36 INT. QUINN'S APARTMENT

36

He enters the apartment and closes the door.

He is about to head to the other room when he spots the X-Men #1 on the table.

He stops and picks it up.

He lets he weight of it sink if for a moment.

37 EXT. WORK OUT PARK

37

James is working out.

QUINN (O.C.)

Hey man.

James looks back to find Quinn walking up.

JAMES

Oh God, what now.

QUINN

What? You acting like you aren't happy to see me.

JAMES

Gee, I wonder why. It can't be, because every time you show up here it's because something major just went wrong in your life. So out with it, what went wrong.

QUINN

(laughs)

Damn dude, uh, well, after we left Dre's house. . .

JAMES

What did you do?

QUINN

I went home. And I uh, I saw the X-Men comic sitting on my table. And it got me thinking. It was like an epiphany.

JAMES

Oh shit, I don't know if I like where this is going.

QUINN

It got me thinking about what you said.

JAMES

Nope, really don't like where this is going.

QUINN

Relax it's not bad.

JAMES

If you say so.

QUINN

Believe me, when something you said makes me see things in a new light, I get worried too.

JAMES

All I'm saying.

QUINN

But it did. Looking at that book, it just, it got me thinking about everything I gave up for that relationship. I lost myself in it. And that isn't Nadia's fault, it's mine. I do that with every relationship. I sold something that means the world to me,

JAMES

Because I told you to.

OUINN

No, because I was so short sided that I actually believed that a relationship would make me whole. That I needed it. My whole life I've been chasing after my Topanga. Because I thought that was what I needed to be happy.

JAMES

But it's not.

QUINN

No it's not. See, I always thought that a good relationship was supposed to be about finding your other half. Finding the person who completes you. Who makes you whole. But that's wrong. It. . .it can't work that way. It just can't, because than you become too dependant on one another. I. . . I got this theory.

JAMES

Let's hear it.

QUINN

I think, before entering into a relationship, you need to be whole. You need to be complete, and then, well, then you find someone else who is complete and you, you don't complete each other you. . .

JAMES

Complement each other.

QUINN

Exactly!

JAMES

That's a good theory.

QUINN

Yeah, and the reason none of my relationships never worked out is, well, I'm not whole yet.

JAMES

You're just half.

QUINN

(laughs)

If that. Shit I might be a quarter.

JAMES

Well, I wasn't going to say anything.

QUINN

Fuck off.

JAMES

Nah, but, it seems like you are in good spirits man.

QUINN

I am.

JAMES

I'm happy for you.

QUINN

Thanks. Once I figured that out, everything just kind of fell into place.

JAMES

Like what?

QUINN

Like how to make myself whole.

JAMES

Really? How so?

QUINN

I put in my two weeks.

JAMES

You did what?

QUINN

I put in my two weeks. That job was killing me man. It. . .it wasn't me.

JAMES

So what are you going to do?

QUINN

I got a job at an indie publisher. I'm going to be doing comics. I mean, it's not the X-Men, but it's a start.

JAMES

It's a step in the right direction.

QUINN

Exactly.

JAMES

I'm happy for you.

QUINN

Thanks man, I mean, it's a pay cut but. . .

JAMES

It'll be worth it.

QUINN

I think so.

JAMES

Good for you.

OUINN

I uh, I came to another conclusion too.

JAMES

And what's that?

QUINN

I think it's time I stopped being Mr. I hate health.

He looks around at all the equipment.

QUINN (CONT'D)

I mean, I'll be honest, I have no idea what any of this does. But, maybe you can teach me.

JAMES

You want to work out? You?

QUINN

(shrugs)

Yeah, yeah I do.

JAMES

You have no idea how long I've been waiting for this day.

James starts showing Quinn how to use the equipment as we
